WATERWORKS RATE POLICY

The Northern Settlement of Missinipe has a combined water and sewer system. The settlement is not metered and has the following water and sewer flat rates:

- \$50.00 per month for permanent residential services
- \$50.00 per month for seasonal commercial users (for a minimum of 6 months)
- \$10.00 charge to turn the water on and off any more than once per year
- \$20.00 charge per hour to steam the water or sewer lines from the property line to inside and or under the building

WATERWORKS CAPITAL INVESTMENT STRATEGY

The objective of the Northern Settlement of Missinipe's investment strategy is to address anticipated waterworks infrastructure maintenance, the immediate drinking water infrastructure problems, and future infrastructure replacements in a timely fashion to ensure the settlement provides safe drinking water to residents and businesses. The strategy uses the 2020 waterworks system assessment as required by *The Waterworks and Sewage Works Regulations, 2015* for infrastructure planning and the 2015 Waterworks System Assessment completed by Associated Engineering as required by SaskWater. With waterworks infrastructure costs being very high and the settlement having a small revenue base, total self-reliance is not possible. Therefore, if significant upgrades or emergency repairs are required, an application will be made to the Northern Municipal Trust Account for funding from the Northern Water and Sewer Program and the Emergency Water and Sewer program respectively.
