

# Local Advisory Committee Elections 2025

## Information Bulletin

### **What is a Northern Settlement?**

A northern settlement is a [District](#) community. The District is a municipality where [Northern Municipal Services](#) (NMS) holds the delegated responsibility to act as the local government authority. Northern settlements are administered in consultation with their local advisory committee.

### **What is a Local Advisory Committee?**

An elected local advisory committee (LAC) acts in an advisory capacity to NMS on the general affairs of the northern settlement.

### **What is the term of a member of a LAC?**

The term of the chairperson and each member of a local advisory committee is 4 years starting at the first meeting of the committee after the election.

### **When was the first meeting of the current LAC?**

The last LAC elections were held in the fall of 2021 and the first meetings were held after the elections.

### **When are the next LAC elections?**

The next LAC elections will be held in the fall of 2025.

### **Why are there no LAC elections this fall?**

LACs are not a municipal council, so do not follow the same schedule as municipal elections. LACs are advisory committee's and follow the schedule of the advisory election. The next advisory elections will be held in the fall of 2025.
