Accumulated revenues may consist of proceeds from Crown land sales, Crown land lease fees, municipal taxes collected and earned interest.

By the end of 2026, the accumulated revenue balance after expenditures is forecasted to be \$47,000. These funds will support ongoing administration and operations of the subdivision, regional arrangements, and future infrastructure projects, such as regional lagoons, landfills and decommissioning projects.
