SNOW REMOVAL POLICY

The Northern Settlement of Uranium City takes reasonable and orderly steps to manage snow and ice hazards on public roadways. During a typical snow event—and for several days afterward—all routes in the Settlement are monitored closely. The priorities are to ensure safe access for public and emergency vehicles, support active transportation, and accommodate seasonal modes of transportation .

At the beginning of the winter season, and during smaller snowfalls that do not significantly hinder travel, snow may be left in place temporarily to help establish a snow base on the roads. This snow base provides insulation for water and sewer lines and creates a safer surface for snowmobile travel, helping prevent damage to machines. We want to balance safety considerations with cost efficiency.

The Settlement is responsible for maintaining and clearing public roadways. Residents and property owners are responsible for clearing snow from private driveways and sidewalks.

Concerns and feedback reach us in different ways. While we may not be able to accommodate every individual preference; our commitment is to serve the community as best we can. Respectful communication is central to the way we serve the community, and when residents reach out to us directly, we make every effort to respond with courtesy and provide reasonable assistance.

GARBAGE COLLECTION FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO PAY \$10 PER MONTH

Garbage will be picked up once a week from those who pay for the service. This garbage needs to be bagged or boxed, not loose. It is not Public Works' responsibility to clean loose garbage from in or around your bin.
